Printing/Copying Allowance for Job Market Candidates

For the school year you are on the job market the printing/copying allowance is as follows:

- Combined printing/copying subsidy of up to 6000 pages on the Canon (the copy machine in the main office);
- 2,000 pages credited to your printing accounts at the beginning of the job market period.
- 400 pages per month for general printing, as everyone else.

You can use any portion of the general printing allowance for print jobs on the Canon over the 6000 free pages limit.

Anything over these limits will be charged at the usual rates for printing or copying respectively.
